RACE RULES & INSTRUCTIONS

DINGHY RACE RULES

US Sailing rules shall prevail except as follows:

- 1. A USCG approved life jacket shall be worn at all times.
- 2. Any class with three or more starters in all days of a series will be scored as a separate class.
- 3. Any contestant winning a complete series in Laser B when all races have had four or more starters is not eligible for future Laser B events unless ruled to the contrary by the dinghy race committee.
- 4. 4. Scoring will be high point, i.e.: one point for starting, one point for finishing and one point for each boat beaten. A withdrawal counts one point while a disqualification counts zero points.
- 5. If nine or more races are held in any one series, one race will be thrown out.
- 6. Requirements for protest flags and written notice are waived.
